



## REPORT ON “RANGOLI COMPETITION” CELEBRATION ON 18<sup>th</sup> OCTOBER 2024

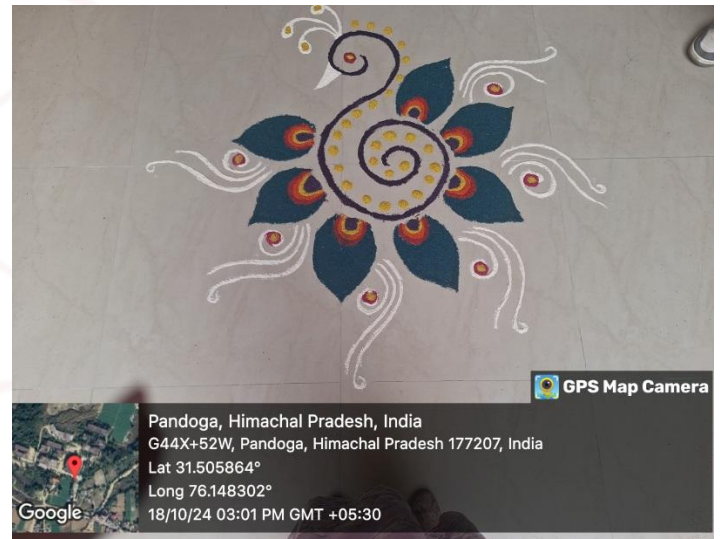
### “DIWALI FESTIVALS OF LIGHT”
