Tunnel Visit Report

Date of Visit: 12th November 2024

Location: Kanjehr, Kangra Division & Ranital, Himachal Pradesh

The Civil Engineering Department of KC Group of Research & Professional Institutes, Pandoga organized an industrial visit to the Kanjehr Tunnel Construction Site on 12th November 2024. The purpose of the visit was to provide students with practical exposure to tunnel construction techniques, machinery, and on-site civil engineering operations.

During the visit, students observed live demonstrations of **bar bending machinery** used in tunnel reinforcement work. On-site engineers briefed the students on **tunneling methods**, **safety protocols**, **and geological challenges** involved in constructing tunnels in hilly areas. The site staff also discussed how **civil engineers coordinate machine operations**, **structural support**, **and labor safety** in confined underground environments.

Students were equipped with safety gear and attentively observed the working environment, gaining first-hand insight into the **complexities of tunnel engineering**. The technical session was followed by a group interaction in **Ranital**, where students discussed logistics and workforce management with the site supervisors.

Key Learnings:

- Tunnel construction methods and support systems
- Use of reinforcement bending machines
- Site safety and field discipline in underground projects
- Real-time interaction with working professionals

Conclusion:

The tunnel visit was a valuable learning experience for the civil engineering students. It enhanced their practical knowledge and helped bridge the gap between academic learning and
